



Thoughts on September 1: Disaster Preparedness Day

This summer, we experienced extremely hot weather, with "Heatstroke Alerts" issued day after day. Although the heat continues, the morning and evening breezes and the sounds of insects are beginning to remind us that fall is near.

We started the second semester on September 1, "Disaster Preparedness Day" in Japan. This day marks the anniversary of the Great Kanto Earthquake, which occurred on September 1, 1923. We have experienced many natural disasters, including the 2024 Noto Peninsula Earthquake and the Oku-Noto Rain Disaster. We cannot always prevent disasters, but our experiences have taught us the importance of helping and cooperating with one another to protect lives and reduce damage.

At Anamizu Junior High School, we have the "AKG (Anamizu Junior High School Crisis Avoidance Guidelines)," created mainly by last year's third-year students. This semester, we will use the AKG to prepare for emergencies and learn how to act calmly when a disaster occurs. The second semester will be full of important events, including the Sports Festival, Cultural Festival, and the third-year students' school trip to the Kanto region. Let us enjoy these events while remembering that disaster preparedness is something that concerns each of us. By sharing our ideas and supporting one another, let us make this a meaningful semester.
