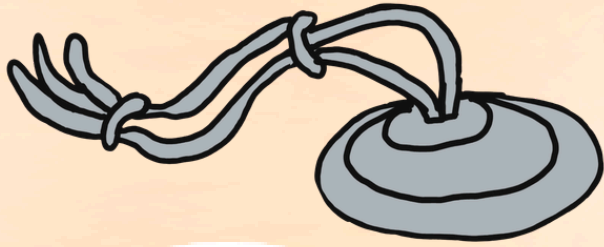


This is what used to look like a UFO flying, called a Souhachibon.

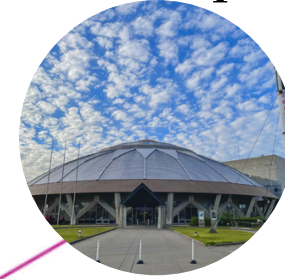
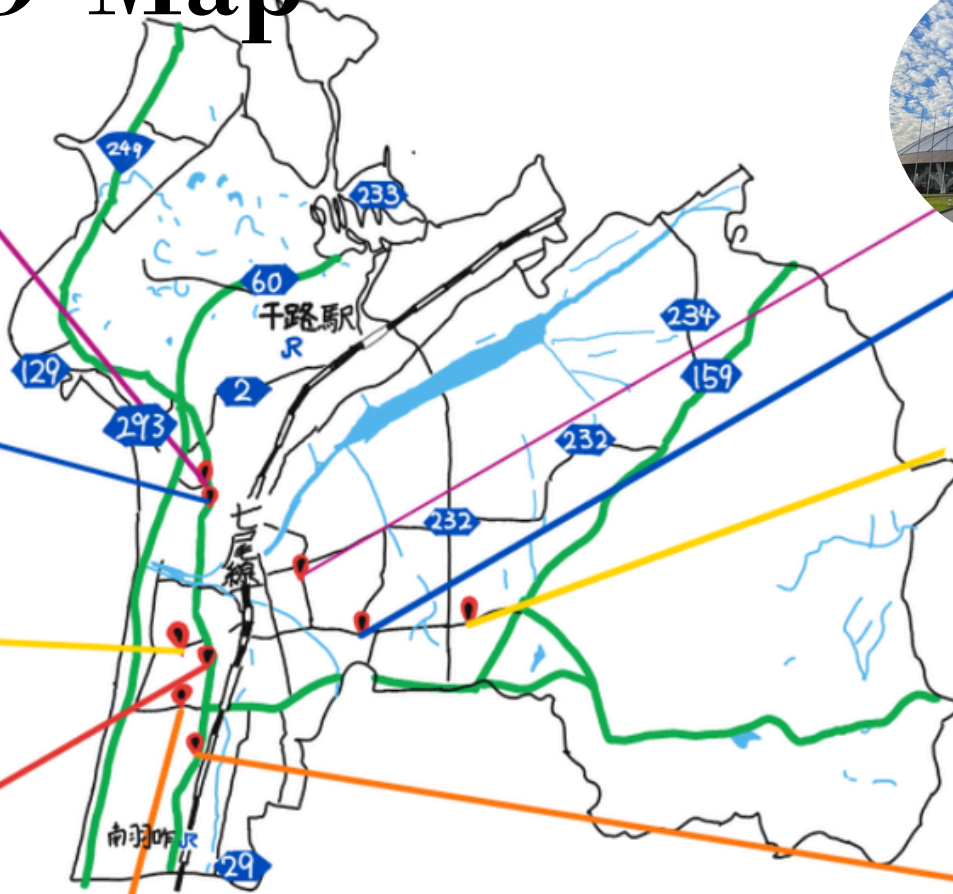
